Entry Requirements: Minimum Entrance Requirements:

- Holders of First degree in Medical Laboratory Sciences degree or its equivalent with overall GPA not less than 2.7.
- Holders of first degree in Health Sciences with overall GPA not less than 2.7 or B grade for unclassified degrees provided they passed with at least B grade or above in Microbiology/Immunology, Molecular Biology or Biochemistry or Cell Biology with at least 200hrs.
- Holders of Bachelor of Science degree in Biomedical Sciences (Microbiology, Molecular Biology, Immunology, Parasitology, Bachelor in Laboratory Sciences) with overall GPA not less than 2.7 provided they passed with at least B grade or above Microbiology/Immunology, Molecular Biology or Biochemistry or Cell Biology.
