

Safety and Security:

Safety and Security around campus:

1. The university premises and the BMC are secured and guarded by contracted security service providers. CCTV cameras are in place, for enhanced security.
2. It is the responsibility of staff, students, visitors and service providers to cooperate with the security guards, for your safety and the safety of others.
3. Each person is first and foremost responsible for their personal property when it is on their person, in the classrooms, hostel or offices.
4. Ensure that doors are properly locked and keys are secured at all times.
5. It is important to be aware of one's immediate environment and alert enough to report anything unusual such as :-
 - broken doors,
 - windows,
 - unattended packages/bags/luggage,
 - suspicious items,
 - unfamiliar persons in the hostel, or on campus
 - suspicious vehicles
 - and suspicious behavior from others.
6. Ensure that your vehicle is parked in the appropriate designated parking space for staff, students or visitors (staff and student owned vehicles require a sticker to be allowed to park within the premises).
7. It is customary to be inspected by security guards, when entering the Bugando premises and during exist.
 - a) Always remember to inform security if you are bringing in something that you intend to exit with later.
 - b) Institutional items taken from offices or the hostel for various purposes must have a signed and stamped 'Gate Pass'.

When on the move:

1. Always carry and wear your ID. Dress code should be observed on Campus.
2. Moving around alone late at night is discouraged.
3. Students are advised to be careful with the transport services they engage for town trips (bodaboda and taxis)
