RESUMING OF ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES AND COVID-19 PREVENTIVE MEASURES


1. All academic activities will resume on the 01st June 2020.
2. All first sessions for all classes on 01st June 2020 should focus on the COVID 19 preventive measures based on the BMC/CUHAS guidelines and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children (MoHCDGEC)
3. All students must register on the special form that is available in the Office of the Dean of students
4. Students must adhere to all COVID 19 preventive measures that include but not limited to:

<i>Parameter</i>	<i>Directives</i>
i. Hand Washing:	Washing hands with soap and water as per directives in all entrances (classes, hostel, Library, offices etc.)
ii. Use of Sanitizers:	Sanitize hands with sanitizers at all points available at BMC/CUHAS
iii. Wearing of Face: Masks(Cloth Mask)	Throughout the hospital/university premises
iv. Group Gathering:	Avoid gathering of not more than 10 students; strictly adhering to social distancing guidelines(2m apart)

5. Students should come with a pair of approved cloth masks
6. Students should follow procedures at main gates of BMC/CUHAS regarding COVID19 preventive measures
7. Any off-campus student who will present with signs and symptoms of COVID-19 should stay at his or her premises and send information to the Dean of students through his/her class representative, and the Dean of Student will consult the BMC-CUHAS COVID-19 Task Force for further interventions.
8. Any in-campus student who will present with signs and symptoms of COVID 19 should report to the University warden, and the warden will consult the BMC-CUHAS COVID-19 Task Force for further intervention.

9. **Students should note that in order to maintain the required social distances in the classes**, there might be frequent changes in teaching venues therefore the class representatives need to obtain updates from Heads of Departments/Lecturers
10. **Students should also note that in order to shorten the duration of lectures**, on-going sessions on the online learning management system will continue to deliver learning materials and assignments, with few lectures to reinforce learning. All students must register in the CUHAS online learning management system
11. To all Undergraduate students who will start end of Semester 1 (2019/2020) examinations, check the examination timetable for the **venue and time in the University website and on the university-wide notice boards** (Note that some examinations will be done between 12.00 and 15.00, in addition to the usual two sessions)
12. The directives will be updated time to time based on the situation and the specific needs. **VISIT THE UNIVERSITY WEBSITE REGULARLY TO OBTAIN THE UPDATES**
